## SUMMARY OF MEMBERSHIP PROVISIONS OF BYLAWS (Effective 5/4/2010)

Membership in Poway Riders Association shall be open to families and individuals interested in civic improvement and any type of equestrian activity.

### TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

Riding Membership / Family shall include one adult, or a couple living as a family unit, and any unmarried children under the age of 18 years living in the same household. The status of any unmarried child included in a Riding or Social Membership who reaches the age of 18 during a Membership Year shall remain unchanged until the following dues date, provided the child remains in the same household. Holders of Riding Memberships shall be entitled to not more than two votes at general meetings, one for each adult member included in the membership present and voting.

Riding Membership / Single shall be open to individuals over the age of 18, not eligible to be part of a family membership as described above. Holders of Riding Memberships / Single shall be entitled to one vote at general meetings.

Social Membership shall be open to individuals and families otherwise eligible for Riding Membership who do not wish to make use of the Association's riding facilities and activities. Social Members shall be entitled to one vote per membership at general meetings. Social Members shall have all other rights and privileges and be subject to the same obligations of membership, EXCEPT the use of facilities for equestrian activities not open to the general public.

### INITIATION FEE (NON-REFUNDABLE)

The Initiation Fee shall be \$100 for Riding Members and \$50 for Social Members. Members converting from Social to Riding membership shall pay the difference between the fees for the two membership types.

### ANNUAL DUES (Effective 5/4/2010)

Riding Membership / Family dues shall be \$150 per Membership Year. Additionally, each member or member family shall do 4 hours of volunteer work per month and shall be assessed \$42 per month during which Work hours are not earned (\$10.50/per hour). (See Bylaws for details.) Working member families and singles shall perform at least 20 work hours by July 31 of each year (prorated for new members joining that year). Failure to do so, without prior Board authorization, will result in suspension of all membership rights and privileges. Membership may be reinstated subject to Board approval and receipt of a special assessment of \$12.00 per un-worked hour for family memberships. A working member family not performing a minimum of 48 work hours by the end of the calendar year is assessed at \$12.00 per un-worked hour. This (and any other) assessment and dues must be paid to become eligible to renew membership or to resign in good standing. *Alternately*, Riding Membership / Family dues shall be \$654 with no work hours required.

Riding Membership / Single dues shall be \$75 per Membership Year. Additionally, each member shall do 4 hours of volunteer work per month and shall be assessed \$21 per month during which work hours are not earned (\$5.25 per hour). Working singles must perform at least 20 work hours by July 31 of each year (prorated for new members joining that year). Failure to do so, without prior Board authorization, will result in suspension of all membership rights and privileges. Membership may be reinstated subject to Board approval and receipt of a special assessment of \$6.00 per un-worked hour (See Bylaws for details.) *Alternately*, Riding Membership / Single dues shall be \$327 with no work hours required.

Social Membership dues shall be \$75 per year with no work hour obligation.

### APPLICATION / MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

Prospective members may apply for Membership by submitting to the Membership Chairperson a completed application and appropriate initiation fee for the type of membership desired. The application shall be submitted to the Board of Directors for acceptance, pending approval of all Membership requirements.

The Membership Chairperson shall introduce applicants to the general membership, make them aware of the responsibilities of Membership and acquaint them with the operation of the Association as well as the activities available.

Once the application for membership has been accepted, the prospective member(s) shall have four months to attend any combination of two regular meetings and/or work parties (minimum 2 hours) prior to acceptance as a regular member. This requirement shall not apply to Social Members.

Upon submission of completed membership application and provisional acceptance by the Board of Directors, applicants shall be billed for prorated dues for the balance of the year and shall be eligible to use PVRA facilities and take part in activities upon payment thereof.
