### **Class Info:**

Leadline riders cannot cross enter into any other classes. Crossrail riders are limited to entries in classes 2 and 3.

All riders jumping 2'3" and lower cannot enter 2'6" or higher classes. Class #12 open to all riders.

Stakes classes accrue no PVRA points.

Cash prizes for the stakes classes are: 1<sup>st</sup> place=\$50.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> place=\$30.00, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place- \$20.00.

Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion ribbons will be given for the Jumper Division.

Ribbons through 6<sup>th</sup> place.

### **Show Info:**

Appropriate show attire (polo shirts are acceptable), riding boots, ASTM/SEI helmets and English saddles required.

Only PVRA members are eligible for PVRA Year-End Hi-Point Awards (excluding classes # 12 and #13). Points accumulate on one horse/same rider combination. Riders with multiple horses must declare which horse will accrue points prior to entering their first class for any points to count. Classes with three or fewer entries may be cancelled. Adds must be requested and paid for (open checks okay) at least two classes in advance. No refunds for scratches or eliminations. Prior show award coupons are now expired and no longer accepted.
